The **Travis County Healthcare District** is seeking a qualified Quality Improvement Nurse who will be responsible for all activities associated with assessing and improving the quality of services and/or care which includes quality planning, assurance and improvement. Examples of job duties include reviewing current industry standards for quality improvement to evaluate the District's Medical Assistance Program (MAP) for performance with the medical industry; assisting in the development and implementation of MAP's quality program plan; designing, maintaining and managing quality-related databases and developing trending and other statistical reports; conducting compliance reviews; providing quality oversight for outsourced activities; assisting in the identification, development, implementation and reporting on disease management programs; and performing other duties as assigned.

Successful applicants must possess knowledge of quality improvement/assurance processes, procedures and guidelines; case and disease management programs/protocols; current medical guidelines; adult and pediatric normal and abnormal conditions/disease processes and current treatment plans; and skill in effective oral and written communication; database design, maintenance and reporting and establishing and maintaining good working relationships.

Minimum Qualifications: A Bachelor's degree in Nursing plus five years of relevant work experience in areas such as managed care, quality assurance/improvement, medical/surgical settings and/or case or disease management programs. Must be a Registered Nurse in the State of Texas
